- Most courses are ONLY OFFERED in one Semester.
- Minimum: 6 ECTS for Semester / Maximum: 30 ECTS for Semester.
- Erasmus+ students can only select courses from the School that they have been admitted to.
- Non-European students can select any of the courses from ALL the Schools.

Most in-demand courses or most impacted courses:

Although our offer in English-taught courses is very wide, there are some of them which are **highly demanded**. We recommend partner institutions to emphasize course flexibility to their students and bring some additional courses approved in case their first options are not always available.
